1.0 CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS – GENERAL

1.01 PURSUANT TO SECTION 34-8-1 (a) OF THE CODE OF ALABAMA, EACH CONTRACTOR MUST SUBMIT WITH THEIR BID PROOF OF LICENSING THROUGH THE ALABAMA STATE BOARD OF LICENSING FOR GENERAL CONTRACTORS, WITH APPROVED MAXIMUM BID LIMITS SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE BID RELATED TO THIS SPECIFICATION. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL BE CAUSE FOR REJECTION OF THE BID.** CONTRACTOR MUST BE LICENSED IN AN AREA OF WORK APPROPRIATE TO THE WORK SCOPE APPLICABLE TO THIS BID PROCESS. CONTRACTOR MUST BE LICENSED AS A PRIME CONTRACTOR. A COPY OF THE CONTRACTOR'S CURRENT YEAR'S LICENSE WILL EXPEDITE THE EVALUATION PROCESS.

1.02 EACH CONTRACTOR MUST SUBMIT WITH THEIR BID PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 PER OCCURRENCE, \$2,000,000 AGGREGATE. EACH CONTRACTOR SHALL FURTHER PROVIDE PROOF OF WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE SUFFICIENT TO SATISFY ALL LEGAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE OF ALABAMA. **FAILURE TO PROVIDE THIS DOCUMENTATION WITH THE BID PACKAGE WILL DELAY EVALUATION OF THE BID.**

1.03 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 41-16-59 OF THE CODE OF ALABAMA, THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER ON THIS SOLICITATION IS RESTRAINED FROM ASSIGNING OR SUB-CONTRACTING ANY PORTION OF THE WORK UNDER THIS CONTRACT.

1.04 AWARD WILL BE "ALL OR NONE" IN ORDER TO INSURE THAT ALL MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES ARE COORDINATED AND EXECUTED IN A MANNER THAT BEST SERVES THE NEEDS AND INTERESTS OF THE DEPARTMENT. LINE ITEMS #00001 THROUGH #00006, INCLUSIVE, WILL BE AWARDED AS A GROUP.

1.05 THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INDEMNIFY AND SAVE HARMLESS THE STATE, THE DEPARTMENT, THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES FROM ALL SUITS, ACTIONS OR CLAIMS OF ANY CHARACTER BROUGHT BECAUSE OF ANY INJURIES OR DAMAGES RECEIVED OR SUSTAINED BY ANY PERSON, PERSONS, OR PROPERTY DUE TO THE OPERATIONS OF THE SAID CONTRACTOR; OR BECAUSE OF OR IN CONSEQUENCE OF ANY NEGLIGENCE IN SAFEGUARDING THE WORK; OR THROUGH USE OF UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS IN CONSTRUCTING WORK; OR BECAUSE OF ANY ACT OR OMISSION, NEGLIGENCE OR MISCONDUCT OF SAID CONTRACTOR; OR BECAUSE OF ANY CLAIMS OR AMOUNTS ARISING OR RECOVERED UNDER THE "WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION ACT" OR ANY OTHER LAW, ORDINANCE, ORDER, OR DECREE; AND SO MUCH OF THE MONEY DUE THE SAID CONTRACTOR UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF HIS CONTRACT AS MAY BE CONSIDERED NECESSARY BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR SUCH PURPOSE, MAY BE RETAINED FOR THE USE OF THE STATE; OR IN CASE NO MONEY IS DUE, HIS SURETY WILL BE HELD LIABLE UNTIL SUCH SUIT OR SUITS, ACTION

OR ACTIONS, CLAIM OR CLAIMS FOR INJURIES OR DAMAGES AS AFORESAID SHALL HAVE BEEN SETTLED AND SUITABLE EVIDENCE TO THAT EFFECT FURNISHED TO THE DEPARTMENT; EXCEPT THAT MONEY DUE THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE WITHHELD WHEN THE CONTRACTOR PRODUCES SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT HE IS ADEQUATELY PROTECTED BY PUBLIC LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

- 1.06 THE CONTRACTOR MUST PROVIDE THE STATE OF ALBAMA WITH A PERFORMANCE BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF THE TOTAL BID PRIOR BEGIN OF WORKPURCHASE ORDER.

2.0 **WORK SCOPE**

- 2.01 ALL WORKMANSHIP SHALL BE OF A PROFESSIONAL QUALITY AND STANDARD AS GENERALLY ACCEPTED IN THE TRADE. ALL WORKMANSHIP IS SUBJECT TO INSPECTION AND APPROVAL BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS (CURRENT EDITION) AND ALABAMA MAINTENANCE MANUAL AS WELL AS ANY STANDARD DRAWINGS, SPECIAL DRAWINGS AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

- 2.02 ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE FACT THAT THIS WORK WILL BE PERFORMED UNDER TRAFFIC CONDITIONS REQUIRING SPECIAL CARE TO EXPEDITE THE WORK AND PREVENT UNDUE HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS. **TRAFFIC CONTROL WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (MUTCD) AND CHAPTER VI OF THE MOST CURRENT EDITION OF THE STANDARDS AND GUIDES FOR TRAFFIC CONTROLS FOR STREET AND HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, UTILITY AND INCIDENTAL MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS.** ATTENTION IS DRAWN TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUB-ARTICLE 630.03 (D) OF THE CURRENT SPECIFICATION.

- 2.03 PRICES TO INCLUDE ALL EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, LABOR AND OTHER NECESSARY INCIDENTALS FOR THE COMPLETION OF THIS WORK IN AN APPROVED AND SATISFACTORY MANNER. NO WORK WILL BE DONE WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL AND NOTIFICATION BY THE DISTRICT ENGINEER AT LOCATION DESIGNATED.

- 2.04 CONTRACTOR IS TO BEGIN WORK WITHIN (30) CALENDAR DAYS FROM RECEIPT OF THE APPROVE PURCHASE ORDER, UPON MOBILIZATION AND BEGINING OF WORK THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE EXPECTED TO SATISFY THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SCOPE OF WORK IN A CONTINOUS AND CONTIUGOUS MANNER UNTIL THE PROJECT IS COMPLETED, INSPECTED AND ACCEPTED.

- 2.05 THE CONTRACTOR IS TO NOTIFY ALDOT OF HIS PROPOSED WORK SCHEDULE AT LEAST 7 DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING OF WORK AS PUT FORTH IN THIS PROPOSAL

- 2.06 THIS BID SUBMITTAL, EACH CONTRACTOR IS AFFIRMING THAT THEY POSSESS, AT THE TIME OF THE BID SUBMISSION, ALL NECESSARY EQUIPMENT, FACILITIES, PERSONNEL AND WORK EXPERIENCE TO PERFORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL SPECIFICATIONS APPLICABLE TO EACH LINE ITEM BID, AND IS PREPARED TO COMMENCE WORK WITHIN FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOURS OF FIRST NOTIFICATION TO PROCEED.

2.07 THE QUANTITIES STATED IN THIS SPECIFICATION AND PROPOSED LIMITS ARE ESTIMATED PUPOSES ONLY AND IN NO WAY OBLIGATES THE STATE TO HAVE ANY SPECIFIC QUANTITY OF WORK PERFORMED.

WORK SCOPE FOR LEVELING AND RESURFACING SR 163 SERVICE ROAD ADJACENT TO DOG RIVER BRIDGE

- ALL ITEMS OF WORK SHALL BE PLACED AND INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2008 EDITION OF THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

- EXISTING ROADWAY SHALL BE SWEEPED AND THOROUGHLY CLEANED OF ALL FOREIGN OR LOOSE MATERIAL AND MAINTAINED IN ADVANCE OF THE SURFACING WORK
- PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF ASPHALT BITUMINOUS OVERLAYS, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE REQUIRED TO CLEAR THE EXISTING EDGE OF PAVEMENT OF ALL TOP SOIL AND VEGETATION
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE THE REQUIRED LEVELING TO THE PROPER GRADE AND LIMITS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER
- COMPACTION OF ALL ASPHALT BITUMINOUS LAYERS SHALL BE TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE ENGINEER. THERE SHALL BE NO PAY FACTOR APPLIED TO THE APHALT BITUMINOUS PAY ITEMS.
- QUANTITIES ARE APPROXIMATE AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE PAID FOR ACTUAL QUANTITIES USED IN THE COMPLETION OF THE PROPOSED WORK. CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT INVOICE UPON SATISFACTORLY COMPLETION OF ALL WORK
- FOR BIDDING AND AWARD PURPOSES, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT UNIT PRICES BASED ON ESTIMATED QUANTITES

- THE CONTRACT SHALL CONSIST OF LEVELING EXISTING PAVEMENT AND OVERLAY WITH A WEARING SURFACE COURSE, FLUSHING NEW EDGE OF PAVEMENT WITH TOPSOIL AND SOLID SOD
- TRAFFIC STRIPE SHALL BE PERFORMED BY STATE FORCES
- ALL NECESSARY TRAFFIC CONTROL SHALL BE PERFORMED AND PROVIDED BY STATE FORCES, TO INCLUDE SIGNS, BARRELS, ARROW BOARDS, FLAGGING OPERATIONS AND LANE CLOSURES AS NEEDED.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND A MANDATORY ON-SITE PRE-BID ON **TBD**
